

How to read the Community Solar Comparison Charts

The charts display the following information:

- Name of company.
- “CUB’s Analysis” links to a CUB review of the offer.
- Whether the company is a....

Developer: A developer builds, owns, and operates a community solar farm.

Community Solar Provider (also known as a “broker”): A community solar provider (or broker) acts as an intermediary, connecting projects with subscribers. Think of community solar providers as sales and marketing agents that acquire and manage subscribers. These companies may sell subscriptions from multiple community solar farms in Illinois.

Community Solar Provider and Developer: Companies are both the developer and the provider, meaning they build and own a farm, and they acquire and manage subscribers. Other developers will hire providers to acquire and manage customers on behalf of the developer.

Companies that serve as providers may sell subscriptions from multiple community solar farms in Illinois.

- The utility territory where the company operates.
- The supply savings offered by the plan.
- The term of the community solar contract.
- Whether the company charges a cancellation fee.
- Whether the company checks your credit.
- Billing details, such as whether the company offers consolidated billing, dual billing or autopay.
- Contact information for the company.

Each chart is designed for a certain customer:

- **Chart 1 displays offers that are open to all customers:** These community solar farms don’t have income requirements. Anyone can subscribe to them.
- **Chart 2 displays Illinois Solar For All (ILSFA) offers:** These community solar farms participate in Illinois Solar for All. ILSFA is a state program that makes solar energy more affordable to income-eligible households (a home with a gross income that doesn’t exceed 80% area median income, or AMI). Farms that are part of ILSFA must follow certain requirements, including that they provide a discount of at least 50% off the utility’s supply price (the utility’s “price to compare,” reported at pluginillinois.org, plus the Purchased Electricity Adjustment). These community solar farms can offer such a generous discount for customers because they are receiving a large incentive through the ILSFA program. **CUB’s recommendation:** If you meet income eligibility requirements, first look for an ILSFA farm. If one is not available, then try one of the non-ILSFA income-eligible farms in Chart 3, described below.
- **Chart 3 displays other offers for income-eligible customers:** These income-qualified community solar farms are separate from ILSFA. The federal investment tax credit provides an “adder” for solar or wind facilities that are either built in low-income communities or that benefit households with lower incomes. To receive the tax credit, at least 50% of the energy produced by these facilities must serve households with incomes below 80% of the area median income (AMI). These offers must provide a discount of at least 20% off the utility’s supply price (the utility’s “price to compare,” reported at pluginillinois.org, plus the Purchased Electricity Adjustment). **CUB’s recommendation:** If you meet income eligibility requirements, first look for an ILSFA farm in Chart 2. If one isn’t available, then try a non-ILSFA income-eligible farm listed in Chart 3.
